Financial Summary

- \$8.9 million investment in an intermediate school for 4th and 5th grades.
- Homeowner tax increase would cost an additional \$178 a year on a \$200,000 home or \$14.84 a month.

Relieves Overcrowded Conditions at Malone Elementary

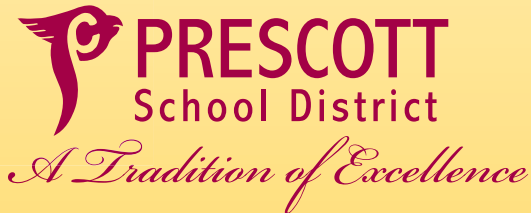
- Currently Malone is overcrowded exceeding the recommended 450-500 students for the building. The student population is predicted to continue growing.

Provides a longer-term solution - Future expansion space available

- The Intermediate School will increase our capacity by 300 students.
- The proposed Intermediate School will be constructed so another level could be added in the future.

Allows for the most cost effective solution - This maximizes the use of current property and saves the taxpayers money

- The cost and availability of land was a deterrent to building on a new site due to the added cost for land and infrastructure requirements.

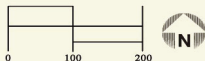
