## PRIDE & ANTICIPATION FOR 2022-23



That time for Prescott Public School's families has arrived. As we commence the new school year, we recognize just-in results from spring High School Advanced Placement (AP) exams and share aspects of our PSD Academic Model to foster continued student success in 2022-23.

Prescott High School students enrolled in AP courses had the option to take an exam in their chosen course. Over 98% of our AP students participated in these exams (a high mark). Impressive student results include:

- With more students enrolled, more student participating in the end of year exams, PHS produced the highest AP test scores in history for PSD
- More students scored a "5" on the exams than ever before.
- AP World History had a 100% pass rate, and five students scored perfect scores!

How do we achieve these results and continue to be the best at getting better? Prescott School district takes pride in its intentional focus on academics, achievement, social-emotional, along with the physical and mental health of our student body. This multi-dimensional focus is represented by the graphic below. We anticipate our sustained focus of Collaboration Time via Monday early release to provide the necessary fuel to keep us moving forward.



Additional efforts being implemented to sustain excellence in 2022-23:

- The School Board approved the administration plan to provide dedicated intervention specialists to support student performance.
- Malone Elementary hired two licensed teachers to provide academic interventions and enhancements.
- MES will also add 1.5 staff members to address K-3 early reading interventions through an AmeriCorps grant.
- Malone Intermediate has a dedicated instructional coach and a math interventionist to design and implement targeted learning experiences for intermediate students.
- Middle School welcomes new math teachers and a full time math interventionist to assist in meeting the full continuum of our students' math proficiency.
- Prescott High School will share the MS math interventionist and adds a full-time math intern to expand our instructional supports.
- Both the high school and middle school will have additional mental health professionals in place to ensure all aspects of student health are addressed.

We are excited to welcome our families and students back to campus for the 2022-2023 school year!
