Return to Learn Fall 2021

#### We believe

- Students are best served on-site, face-to-face with highly-qualified staff -- five days a week.
- Providing programs that address the academic, cognitive, mental, social-emotional, and physical needs of all students is essential AND is best accomplished on site.
- Current infectious rates are at levels we have successfully navigated
  - Especially 4K-Grade 5
  - As staff and secondary student vaccination rates increase, we increase the probability of sustaining on-site programming. August 24th @ MIS
- Staff performed heroically providing on-site and concurrent simulcast instructional programming during HYBRID learning (6-12).
  - These models were provided under emergency situations and admirably executed.
  - However, these efforts are not sustainable for staff and our families.

### Mitigation Steps

- 1. Vaccinations ages 12+ eligible
  - a. Staff are eligible and clinics are accessible for all employees
  - Students ages 12+ who are vaccinated are exempt from quarantine and close contact
  - c. Estimated opportunity for vaccinations below 12 years of age by late fall
- 2. Highly recommend masks, especially for individuals unable to be vaccinated
  - There are agencies external to PSD that have the authority to order/mandate face-coverings
  - b. At this time, none of these authorities are mandating face coverings.
  - Administration is aligned with recommending, but does not see a need to go above and beyond these agencies
- 3. Physical distancing, spacing, hand washing, & increased ventilation\*
- 4. Symptom Checks--If symptomatic stay home.
  - Daily self-screening and testing when unsure

# District and site protocols will be based on...

- Safety--Implement proactive mitigation strategies to keep students and staff as physically and emotionally safe as possible regardless of the specific learning environment.
- *Coherence--*Aligning responses to the school's mission, vision, and policies.
- *Equity*--Meet the diverse needs of all students by actively researching and providing the resources students need to succeed.
- <u>Flexibility</u>--Prepare for short- and long-term shifts, adjustments, and changes throughout the year.

# We recommend--Board Approved 8-18-21

- 1. The School Board and Administration will abide by and follow mandates and orders put in place by entities with authority and jurisdiction over PSD.
- 2. Students and drivers on PSD buses will adhere to CDC-Public Transportation order to wear a mask.
- 3. Face coverings are highly recommended, but are not required on district property.
- 4. PSD will collaborate and cooperate with DHS, DPI, and PCPH
  - a. PSD will observe quarantine orders for positive COVID-19
  - b. Close contacts--PSD will communicate to families of positive cases
    - i. More detailed contract tracing or close contact identification PCPH domain
- 5. Our website will report out the following metrics:
  - a. Number of active positive cases for the week
  - b. Cumulative number of active cases
  - c. Percent of the community vaccinated
